

# Upper Key Stage 2

## Yr 5-6

### The race to reproduce

This workshop builds on student's knowledge of different lifecycles in animal groups. They will be encouraged to describe the processes behind each stage of growth and look at why animals have different methods. They will also be introduced to the different methods of sexual reproduction seen in animals.

### Forever changing

This workshop will introduce students to the concept of evolution. By looking at some of our modern dinosaurs (birds) they will identify the link between dinosaurs and birds and discuss advantageous and disadvantageous variation across species.

### Egg-citing tour

This tour is very similar in content to 'the race to reproduce' workshop, but with a greater emphasis on bird reproduction and growth. Students will gain an incite into bird development within and outside the egg. (Due to bird breeding habits this tour is best booked during late spring and summer time.)

### Forever changing tour

Very similar to the workshop, students will look at a wider range of birds to discuss the concept of evolution and the need for variation across species. Students will be encouraged to identify and discuss advantageous and disadvantageous variation across the animals they look at.
